<p><b>3</b> <b>Name of the personal data file</b></p>	<p>Data file of Defence Forces media service users (media representatives) and list of those invited to press conferences</p>
<p><b>4</b> <b>Reason and Judicial Basis for Handling Personal Data</b></p>	<p>The purpose of the storage is to identify the representatives of the media and to grant them access to the Finnish Defence Forces online media service. Approved users will gain access to the services and content of the Finnish Defence Forces media service website. Invitations for press conferences will be sent using the same service. The data is collected to ensure that the users of the media service and those invited to functions and press conferences by the Finnish Defence Forces Public Information Branch are representatives of the media. The data is used by the Finnish Defence Forces Public Information Branch to serve the media. The media service that the database consists of is an add-on to the Defence Forces puolustusvoimat.fi website.</p> <p>By registering as a user of the service you are giving your consent, per EU GDPR art 6 item 1a, for processing your personal data for the purpose mentioned above.</p>

<p><b>6</b>  <b>Personal Data Origin and Regular Sources of Data</b></p>	<p>The subscriber of the service provides the necessary data when registering as a user.</p>
<p><b>7</b>  <b>Personal Data Recipients or Categories of Recipient</b></p>	<p>The personal data is managed by the personnel representatives of the Finnish Defence Forces Public Information Branch.</p>
<p><b>8</b>  <b>Data Transfer to a Third Country or to an International Organisation (European Commission adequacy decision or knowledge of documents about adequate safeguards if transfer is based on article 46 or article 49 sub-paragraph 1b)</b></p>	<p>No information disclosure and transfer of data outside EU or European Economic Area. Data files not be shared with a third party.</p>

<p><b>9</b>  <b>Data Storage Period/ Criteria for Determining Period</b></p>	<p>The personal data in the subscriber service for media will be stored until the subscriber notifies they wish to end using the service. Special cases are such people who are no longer employed by the media they are registered under, and this is noted by the Finnish Defence Forces Public Information Branch. In this case the Public Information Branch will delete the registered person from the service. A representative from the Public Information Branch will contact the person before their information is deleted.</p>
<p><b>10</b>  <b>Possible Use of Profiling (Meaningful Information on the Handling Logic, Significance and the Envisaged Consequences for the Data Subject)</b></p>	<p>The Finnish Defence Forces will not use the information for automated decision making or profiling. All users of the service have access to the same content.</p>
<p><b>11</b>  <b>Principles for securing data file</b></p>	<p>Data files not be shared with a third party.  The data is used by the Finnish Defence Forces Public Information Branch to serve the media.</p> <p>The media service, that the data file is made of, is an add-on to the Finnish Defence Forces' puolustusvoimat.fi site.</p> <p>The data files are protected in the same way as with the entire central government ICT platform (Valtori manages and is responsible for the functionality and legality of the product).</p>
<p><b>12</b>  <b>Right to Request Access to and Rectification or Erasure of Personal Data or Restriction of Processing</b></p>	<p>The data consists of information supplied by the data subject. The data subject can edit their own data using the functionalities of the media service. If the data subject wishes to have their information deleted, they can do so by contacting the Finnish Defence Forces feedback email <a href="mailto:puolustusvoimat@mil.fi">puolustusvoimat@mil.fi</a>.</p> <p>Restricting the processing of data is not possible. The use of the service user may have their information deleted if they so wish and to reapply for rights to use the service. The same grounds are used for re-granting the right to use the service as with new users.</p>

<p><b>13</b>  <b>Right to Object to Processing as well as the Right to Data Portability</b></p>	<p>The subscriber(data subject) has the right to object to the data handling if they feel that their information has processed in an illegal way. Only the data provided by the subscriber is in the file. The subscriber can access their own personal data through the service.</p> <p>If the data subject so desires, the Defence Command will give them their information that has been stored in the system.</p>
<p><b>14</b>  <b>Right to Withdraw Consent at Any Time (if Handling is Based on Consent)</b></p>	<p>The data subject has the right to withdraw his or her consent at any time.</p>
<p><b>15</b>  <b>Right to Take the Matter to the Data Protection Ombudsman</b></p>	<p>According to article 77 of the GDPR every data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, in particular in the Member State of his or her habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.</p> <p>The data subject may lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Ombudsman, if they consider that we infringe the current data protection legislation.</p>
